

Sangudo Community Gardens



Now accepting applications for the 2022 Season!

The Sangudo Public Library is pleased to announce the establishment of the **Sangudo Community Gardens**, supported by the Government of Canada's Healthy Communities Initiative grant! Raised garden beds have been built adjacent to the Library building (at 5028 - 50 Ave.) to provide **free, accessible growing space for community residents**.

We are accepting applications for garden plots for the 2022 growing season. Plots will be allotted on a first-come-first-served basis, with the intent of meeting the needs of as many people as possible. Applicants can apply for whatever amount of space they would like to use - we currently have 10 raised bed planters (8 ft. long x 3 ft. wide x 2 ft. tall) available, but if interest exceeds this capacity, our aim is to build more to meet demand!

Rainwater tanks will be set up on-site in the spring for convenient garden use, and the Library will soon be launching a tool-lending library through which Library patrons and community gardeners can obtain garden tools.
